It is mandatory for international students who are studying for more than 6 months (one semester). The aforementioned visa holders will be automatically subscribed to the NHIS. The subscription information will be mailed to the address written in the Alien Registration Card.</p>																								

23	Visa Issuance	<p>Visa Issuance</p> <p>As citizens of countries other than Korea, students must apply for a relevant visa at an overseas Korean Embassy or Consulate to study in Korea. In order to apply for a valid visa(type: D-2-6), students must submit the required documents to the embassy. Since visa issuance process may take a considerable time, you are requested to submit the required documents as soon as you get the certificate of admission from CUK.</p>
