





ELIGIBILITY

- Submission of completed online application AND
- Any undergraduate or graduate students currently enrolled in university OR
- Prospective students entering university in September 2019

- scanned copy of college or university enrollment or transcript
- scanned copy of passport bio-page
- scanned copy of overseas traveler's insurance
